Human Rights & Fair Labour Practices

We believe in treating all of our employees fairly and humanely, and we subscribe to Malaysia's labour laws as well as the International Labour Organisation (ILO)'s Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work. During peak harvest season, our mill workers tend to work longer hours to ensure FFB are processed before their quality deteriorates. However, we ensure that they DO NOT EXCEED THE OVERTIME LIMIT as set by the Department of Labour.
